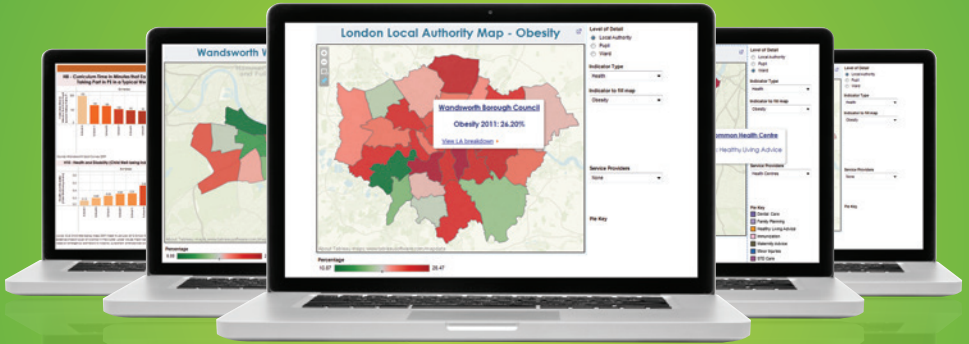

Introducing **DataPix**, the visual analysis tool developed for Wandsworth Children and Young People's Partnership by Mime Consulting. **DataPix** provides decision makers with a robust evidence base for:

- Planning and commissioning services
- Demonstrating impact and effectiveness
- Identifying strengths and weaknesses in performance

DataPix pulls together a wide range of performance and activity data at local authority, cluster, ward and person level. This ranges from publically available data such as school performance, health data and crime statistics, to your own data on the uptake of your services.

Key Features:

Visual – Colour-coded analysis makes it easy to identify issues

Web-based – Access from any Internet enabled device

Interactive – Sort, filter, drill-down and more

Multi-levelled – Data ranges from national to local to individual level

The DataPix main menu provides access to two types of analysis: standard PDF cluster packs, and interactive reports.

A. Standard Cluster Packs

B. Interactive Reports

The interactive reports below allow the creation of custom reports on a range of topics, including interactive maps. Note that they are only available to a limited set of authorised interactive users.




1. Interactive Cluster Report

Interactive versions of the standard PDF cluster profiles. You can dynamically create your own group of areas (for example, compare three particular wards side by side), and choose which time period to look at for particular indicators.




2. Interactive Ward Map

An interactive map allowing you to visually demonstrate the difference between different wards for a range of indicators (NB, Only indicators available at ward level can be analysed)



3. Pupil Level Analysis

Interactive pupil level analysis that allows you to explore the characteristics of Wandsworth schooled pupils (based on school census data), either on a pupil map, or in tabular form.



4. FIS Service Map

An interactive map of the services listed by Wandsworth's Family Information Service. You can show all services, or just those with a particular service category (e.g. disabilities, or relationships).

A. Standard Cluster Packs available to all Wandsworth registered users

B. Interactive Reports for Interactive Licence Holders

Where a visualisation is available to all Wandsworth users **green call outs** are used. Where **blue call outs** are used an interactive log-in is required.

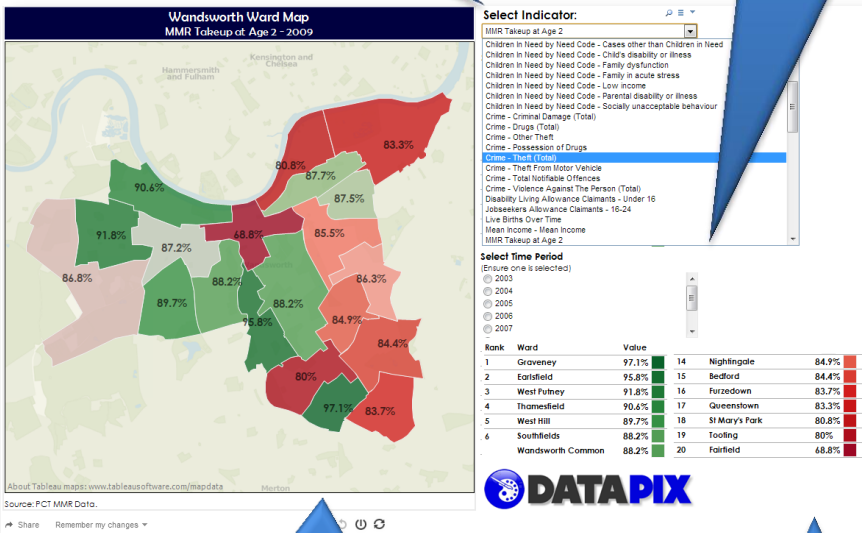

Interactive Ward Map

DataPix Interactive Ward Maps provide interactive license holders the ability to visually assess how different wards compare on over 60 indicators, as well as providing easy access to the underlying data.

Select from a drop down of over 60 different indicators to see areas of interest.

For some indicators you are able to look at data from previous years to track trends through time.



Colour coded maps allow patterns to be assessed visually and efficiently to help locate areas to explore further.

A ranked list of the wards is also displayed along with the data for quick analysis.

Pupil Level Analysis

DataPix Pupil Level Analysis allows child data to be displayed at postcode level. Different colour coding and filters can be applied. Data can also be viewed in table format with the ability to build up custom crosstabs.

Colour dots by characteristics such as *IDAC1*, *FSM eligibility*, *ethnicity*, *SEN stage*

Filter by *Phase of education*, *School year*, *Institution*, *SEN type*
